The activities will take place from 9-11am starting Monday, April 10th through Friday, April 14th. Cost is \$197 per athlete with a sibling rate of \$297 for two members of the same household. Ten percent of the proceeds will be donated back to your school.

The athletic camp is invitational and exclusively for the dedicated student-athletes. Again, ten percent of the proceeds will benefit your school sports program.

All Sport Conditioning

Activities include conditioning drills such as sledgehammering tires, tire flipping, weighted sled pulls, 50' battling ropes, kettlebell swinging, Bosu balancing recovery, Landmine (vertical barbell on pivot box), cutting pole runs, jump rope progressions coordinated with ball handling, agility ladder, and mini hurdles. TRX suspension training straps, medicine ball and tornado ball drills done against solid concrete walls outdoors. All techniques are instructed and progressed appropriately. No student is left behind in these progressions. Modifications will be introduced so that a positive experience is had by all. See this [video of these activities](#) done by all ages.
